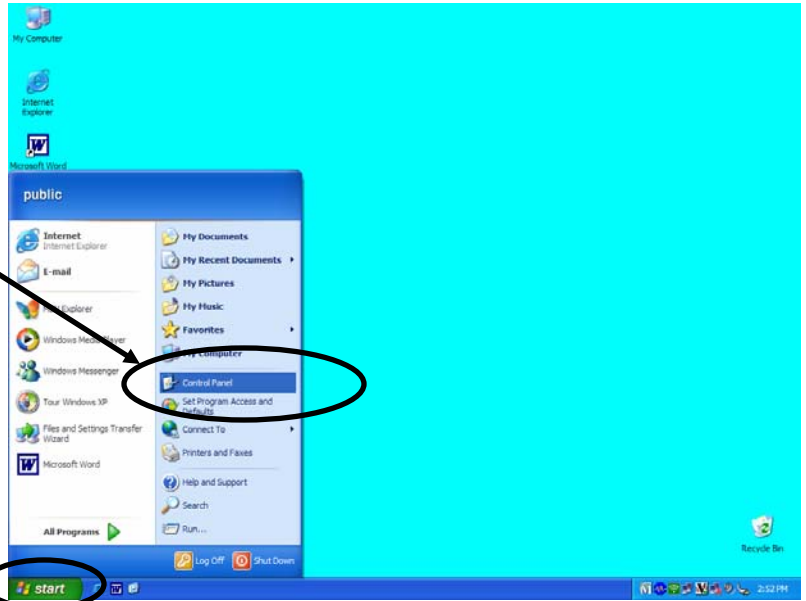


Control Panel Windows XP

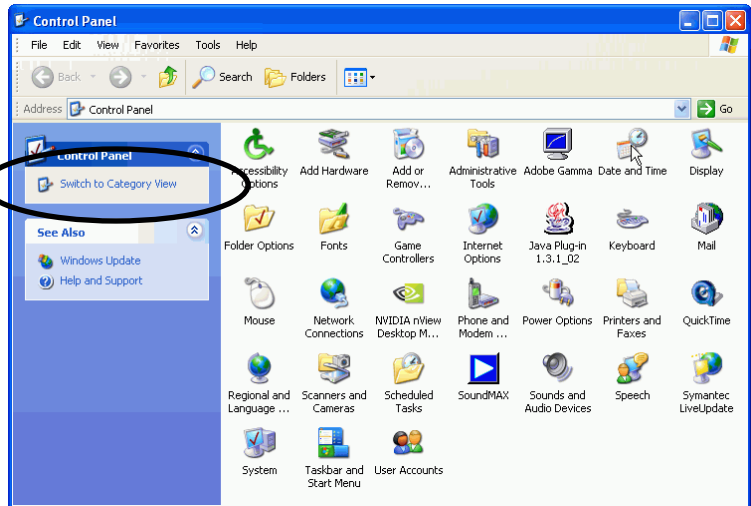
Click the *Start* button and then click on *Control Panel* in the list of items displayed in the right column.

Classic view allows choosing options from a list of items. The window on the right is displaying the Control Panel in Classic View.

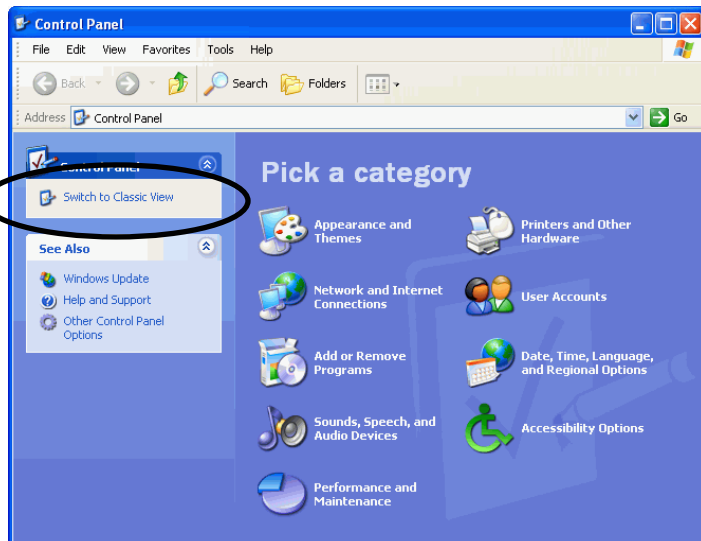
Click on the *Switch to Category View* in the task pane on the left side of the window to display the Control Panel in Category view.

To switch back to Classic view, click *Switch to Classic View* in the task pane on the left side of the window.

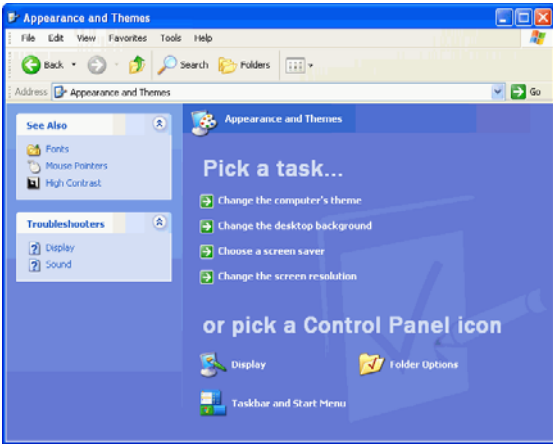

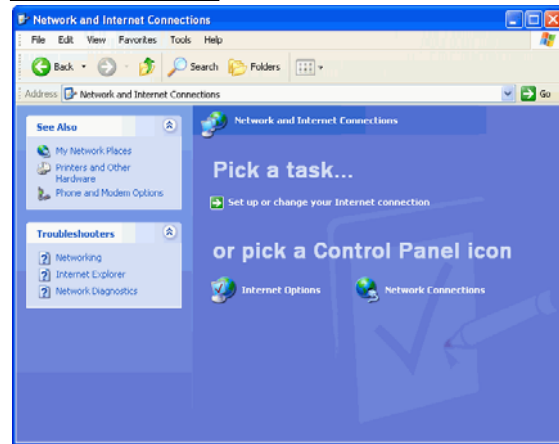
 Accessibility Options Options for changing computer settings to accommodate vision, hearing, and mobility difficulties	 Network Connections Provides access to network connection options
 Add Hardware Runs the Add Hardware wizard to allow installation of new hardware	 Phone and Modem ... Options for setting up modem and phone connections
 Add or Remove... Allows installation of new software or removal of existing software.	 Power Options Provides access to power saving settings and automatic power features
 Administrative Tools Tools to manage computers, services, system components, and networking	 Printers and Faxes Options for printers and faxes including installing new printers and setting default printer
 Date and Time Set the computer clock and calendar	 Regional and Language ... Provides access to settings associated with languages, number formats, currency formats, time and date
 Display Change the desktop background, desktop and window colors, screen saver, screen resolution, and settings for video card and monitor	 Scanners and Cameras Allows management, installation and configuration of scanners and cameras
 Folder Options Options for changing the look and behavior of folders and changing double clicking to single clicking.	 Scheduled Tasks Allows choosing a task to run at a specific time
 Fonts Displays all of the fonts installed and allows for adding and removing fonts	 Sounds and Audio Devices Options for managing speakers, microphones, and system sounds
 Game Controllers Allows installation, removal, and troubleshooting of game controllers	 Speech Options for settings related to accessibility options related to speech
 Internet Options Accesses settings associated with the internet such as history, home page, security, browser cache, connections, and internet-related programs	 System Provides access to the system settings such as the Hardware Wizard, Device Manager, and gives system information
 Keyboard Allows changing keyboard options such as character repeat speed, cursor blink rate, and installation of special hardware	 Taskbar and Start Menu Options for changing the appearance of the Taskbar and Start Menu
 Mail Installs and removes mail accounts and services such as Microsoft Outlook Internet mail accounts and Exchange Server accounts	 User Accounts Allows changing user account settings and passwords
 Mouse Allows changing mouse options such as right/left hand settings, double click speed, and pointer style

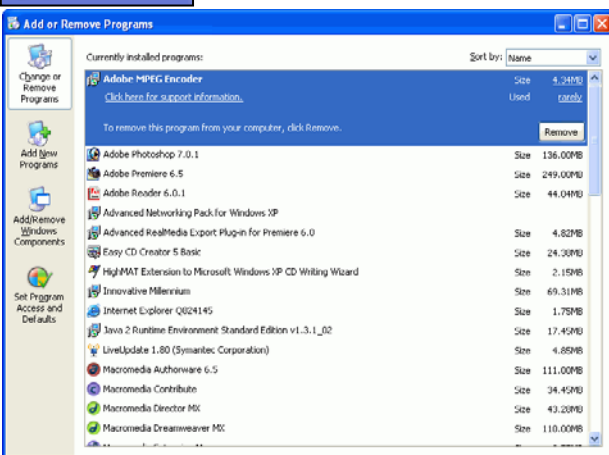

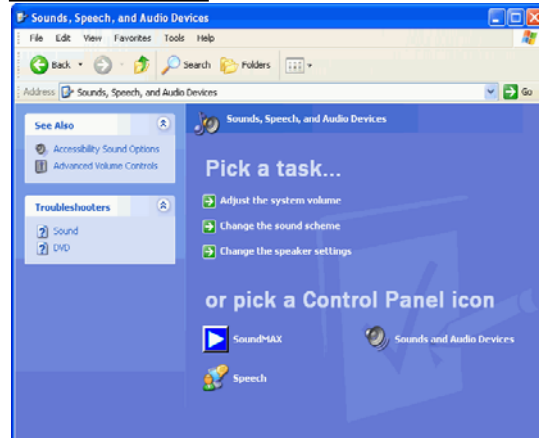

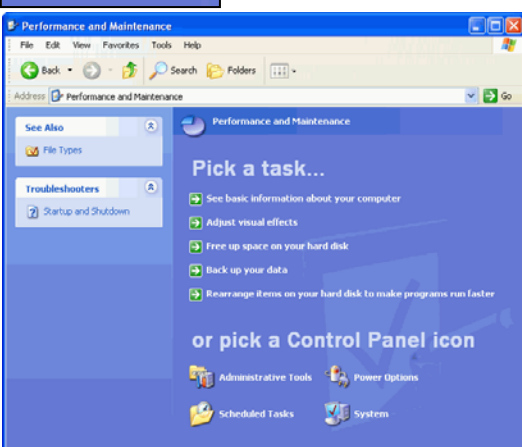

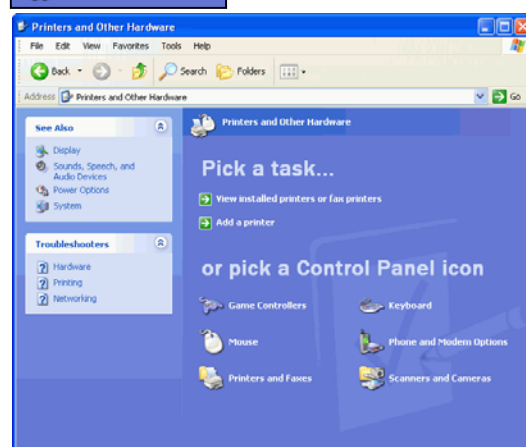
