

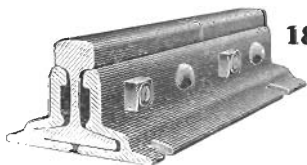

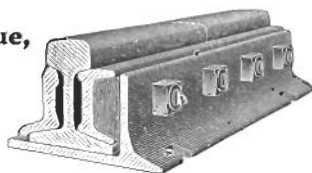

Railroad Baiting

With true appreciation of the facts and with admirable courage President Wilson declared that the railroads were almost the only business interest of this country which immediately concerned everybody, and that they were in need of more revenue.
