Scope:	<p>Dona L. Barski of Springfield, Mo donated this World War II collection of photographs and books from her husband, Stanley Robert Barski, and father Charles E. Lunn. Her husband enlisted in the Navy in 1942 and served for 20 years. After World War II he served as Chief Petty Officer in charge of maintenance of the aircraft on Guam in the South Pacific. Her father enlisted in the Army Air Force as a 2nd Lieutenant in 1942 and served until the end of the war. Lunn had a collection of 48 slides made by Castle Films documenting World War II which are included in this collection. Photographs of both Barski and Lunn are included as well as a photograph of Barski's tombstone in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery. A few air navigation books and an air training manual are a part of this collection.</p>
